

# **ICD-10 Codes for Family Planning Services**

The purpose of this job aid is to provide a comprehensive list of ICD-10 codes for family planning services, including contraceptive visits, sexually transmitted infection services, female and male genital tract conditions, achieving pregnancy and basic infertility services, and other selected counseling services. Family planning agencies can customize this list based on the services they provide.
